

TOWN OF GRANBY CLERK REMINDERS

DOG LICENSES: All residents who licensed their dogs through the Town Census should have received their dog tags. If you did not receive your dog tag call the clerks office.

FOR RESIDENTS WHO HAVE NOT LICENSED THEIR DOGS: March and April are the months to license (bylaws of the Town of Granby CH XIV). The cost is \$6.00 for spayed or neutered, and \$15.00 for others. To avoid a \$25.00 late charge fee dogs should be licensed by May 1st. If you wish you may license by mail. Please include a copy of the rabies vaccination or call the clerks office for verification, a stamped self-addressed envelope, a check made payable to the Town of Granby, and mail to Town Clerk, 215 B West State Street Granby, MA

RABIES CLINIC: A rabies clinic will be held on Saturday, March 24th, behind Kellogg Hall 10:00 am – 12:00 noon. Cost per animal is \$15.00. Please have dogs on a leash and cats in a carrier. If at all possible bring your pets last rabies certificate. Dog licensing and voter registration will also be available at this clinic.

THIRD AND FINAL NOTICES ON THE 2012 ANNUAL TOWN CENSUS:

Confirmation notices will be mailed to all voters who did not answer their Town Census as required by MA General Laws Ch 51, Sec 4.

Therefore, all voters who do not answer this mailing will be designated as “Inactive” on the Granby Voting List.

To avoid any voting problems please mail back this post card. If you did not received an Annual Town Census or would like to check on your voting status call the town clerks office for verification.

NOMINATION PAPERS: Any person interested in seeking elected office in Granby must take out papers from the town clerk no later than Thursday, March 29th in order to be placed on the Monday, May 21st ballot.

Warrant Articles: The Annual Town Meeting will be held on Monday, May 14th. The last day to file a private warrant article for the Annual info@granbytv.org Town Meeting is Friday, March 30th.

In order for a private warrant article to appear on the Annual Town Meeting warrant, a petitioner must acquire ten (10) signatures of registered voters in the town.
