Greetings:


In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and town affairs, to meet at the Granby Junior-Senior High School on East State Street in said Town on Monday, the twenty fourth day of October next, at 7:00 P.M., then and there to act on the following article, to wit:


ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, borrow or bond, transfer from available funds or transfer from the Stabilization Fund the sum of \$861,000, or a greater or lesser amount, for the purpose of constructing a new Granby public library, or take any other action in regard thereto.

And you are hereby directed to serve this warrant by posting attested copies thereof at five or more public places as of the bylaws before the time of said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make due return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk at the time and place of meeting aforesaid.
