

## ATTENTION RESIDENTS

As of Mid-November, solid waste is no longer being buried in the landfill. All materials brought to the transfer station are being trucked to other landfills.

The Town has reached an agreement with Waste Management to keep the transfer station running as usual, until the end of March. **If you have a sticker that expires December 31, 2013, that sticker IS VALID until the end of March.** The Town bags must still be used.

We are in the process of reviewing proposals for a town-wide curbside pick-up. RFP's are due December 20 and the Board will review them, select what appears to be the best deal for our residents then negotiate a contract with the company. We hope to award the contract during the first week of January

As soon as this process is complete, we will notify you of the results and, if you wish, you can sign up for that service. Some of you may wish to seek your own company, which is fine. The more people that participate in the town wide program, the better the price we are apt to receive.

We know you will have questions about bulky items, yard waste, etc. We hope to address all of those concerns in the contract or by providing other alternatives.

We are expediting this process and appreciate your patience.

Also, as permitted by DEP and with the agreement of the Fire Chief, the Town will be conducting a Christmas tree burning event this year. Per the Fire Department, you will be able to drop off your live Christmas tree at a designated area on the Kendall Street side of Dufresne Park for the period December 30, 2013 through January 6, 2014. The Fire Department will be burning the trees on the night of January 6, 2014.
