



The Town of Granby Waste Reduction Program



**Keep Granby clean one bag at a time.
Go green, stay clean.**

ALL trash being disposed of at the Granby Transfer Station must be placed in official, Town of Granby blue trash bags.

- Trash that is not in the official Town of Granby bag will be rejected.
- An annual landfill sticker is required for the use of the Transfer Station. Stickers are available at 10A West State St.
- The new bags should be securely tied and must not exceed 30 lbs. (15 lbs. for small bag)
- There is **no limit** to the amount of recyclables that may be brought to the Transfer Station for recycling.
- The dumpsters for recycling remain the same. **Mixed Containers:** includes glass, metal and aluminum bottles and cans, 1-7 plastics (no #6 Styrofoam cups or boxes), clear plastic clam shells, aluminum foil, empty aerosol cans, milk & juice cartons. **Paper and Recyclables:** includes office paper, magazines, cardboard, cereal boxes (no liners), paperback books, clean pizza boxes and newspaper. **Scrap Metal:** metal items that don't qualify as Mixed Containers may be recycled in the scrap metal dumpster. - Bulky items, which include items such as electronics/CRTs, appliances, fluorescent bulbs, furniture, mattresses, carpets, etc. may be brought to the Granby Transfer Station. Fees may apply, and bulk items must be paid for at 10A West State St before going to the Transfer Station.
- No hazardous materials or construction/demolition debris is accepted at the Transfer Station.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- The Transfer Station is closed on these holidays: New Years Day, July 4th, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas.
- Transfer Station Hours are Tuesday 7:00am-5:00pm, Thursday 7:00am-5pm, and Saturday 7:00am-4pm.
- This Waste Reduction Program is for drop off trash at the Transfer Station only. Residents may enter into a private subscription service at that company's rate.
- By recycling, composting, donating goods and purchasing goods with less packaging, residents can reduce the amount of waste disposed of, and the number of bags needed.
