 - c) Energy Conservation, Inc. Never completed Assessment = No Report

These type of Assessments are "Free" and arranged through National Grid thus you get what you pay for = Not much

Conclusion - Not an effective way to evaluate buildings & plan energy improvements

Recommendation - Granby Energy Committee to schedule Level II Energy Assessments

 - (5) New Library Depending on cost, may not include baseline now since building is relatively new
 - (6) Schools Currently, Granby committed to renovation & new building
 - (a) Consider establishing an Energy Baseline upon work completion FY2018? Possibly in conjunction with the new Library

<u>Conclusion</u> – Proper Assessment to establish the building's baselines & cost to reduce energy consumption required for an accurate decision-making process

<u>Recommendation</u> - Committee recommends using existing Green Community Funds to pay for Level II Energy Assessments
