THE NEW GRANBY FREE PUBLIC LIBRARY

- One story design with maximum **accessibility** to all patrons.
- Display cases for community and library postings.
- Central Reading Hall with clear views to all Library areas.
- Expanded Circulation Desk Area with sufficient room for patrons and staff.
- Expanded **book collection area** (fiction, non-fiction, large print) orderly, logical, clearly signed.
- Display Areas for **new books**.
- **Self Check-Out** bays.
- Audiovisual area that can adjust to new technologies.
- Expanded Children's Library Area with a Program Room that also can be used as quiet study area.
- Young Adult Room.
- Multipurpose **Meeting Room** accessible after hours for use by the community.
- Multipurpose small Conference and Quiet Study Room with seating for 12.
- Group Study/Local History/Genealogy Room with space for local history and genealogy study.
- **Reference Area** with a collection of both print and electronic reference resources with sufficient workspace.
- **Periodical Reading Area** with sufficient display areas and room for browsing.
- Small area with **comfortable seating** where patrons can relax and/or access the **wireless Internet**.
- Sufficient seating, computers, and workspaces throughout.
- Ample **parking** for all patrons.

Thanks to the expected Massachusetts Board of Library Commissioners Construction Grant and donations and pledges in-hand, we have raised currently over 70% of the total cost of the project.

Our first goal is to match a challenge pledge of \$150,000.
