"Fugler"-East St- Enforcement Order- Opened at 7:30. Represented by Mr. Kevin Brooks. Presented revision of restoration map at 1"=20", added contours, displayed soil borings and a representative cross section between soil pits 1-3.

Letter that was presented 11-27-17 was read in by EC- 1) Revised plan 2) representative cross section 3) and planting schema. Presented erosion control/restoration mix for moist sites.

Discussion of the plant species proposed for planting. Proposal included (6) winterberry and (5) red maple scattered around the outsides. WeL suggested adding watering bags. Locally sourced is also suggested. WeL suggested (2) red osier dogwoods to be placed.

Vegetation plugs are requested by the Commission to be determined by Mr. Brooks after consulting with a local company.

Reviewed the checklist of requested items.

Target wetland elevation is going to be approximately 237.7

One cross section was presented- EC was satisfied with the cross section

Post-construction report is requested by the Commission.

The commission would like to be onsite during the initiation of construction.

Some pit and mound topography needs to be implemented.

Topsoil should be evaluated before plantings.

Discussion of permanent vs. temporary access through the RA and the alternatives analyses. Melissa Cody of Tighe & Bond.

Discussion of orientation of the panels- input by Jean Christy re: slope facing of the panels. Mr. Scott asserts that that entire steep portion is outside the wetland and buffer.

Rec'd Peer review from Tighe & Bond on 11/28/17- presented by Melissa Cody from T&B and Jean Christy. T&B was in agreement with the delineation that is proposed. Saturated soils visible on aerials in the agricultural field were reviewed.

Riverfront Area performance standards opinion was reviewed.

Jean Christy reviewed the Stormwater Management report. Two of the three arrays are flat with amenable soils. One array is on a steeper slope and a recommendation was made to incorporate a drip edge provision into an O&M plan. The remaining Stormwater Management standards were reviewed.

ConCom requested that the access off Morgan Street be staked out for ConCom field review.
