FLOOD PLAIN DISTRICT REGULATION

The Board of Health of the Town of Granby, acting under the authority of the General Laws and amendments and additions thereto, and by any other power thereto enabling, and acting thereunder and in accordance therewith, have, in the interest of and for the preservation of the public health, duly made and adopted the following rule and regulation.

The Board of Health, in reviewing all proposed water and sewer facilities to be located in the Flood Plain District established under the Zoning Bylaws, shall require that:

- 1. new and replacement water supply systems be designed to minimize or eliminate infiltration of flood waters into the systems, and
- 2. new and replacement sanitary sewage systems be designed to minimize or eliminate infiltration of flood waters into the systems and discharges from the systems into flood waters.

Approved and adopted by the Granby Board of Health September 24, 1979.
