INSTALLER'S – HAULER'S COMPLIANCE SIGNOFF

The Board of Health voted at their meeting on April 15, 1998 to follow Title 5 Regulations regarding the signing of Certificates of Compliance. According to 15.021 of 310 Code of Massachusetts Regulations for signing the Certificates of Compliance on Disposal Works Construction Permits, the code states:

Prior to the issuance of a Certificate of Compliance, the Disposal System Installer and Designer shall certify in writing on a form approved by the Department that the system has been constructed in compliance with 310CMR 15.000, the approved design plans and all local requirements, and that any changes to the design plans have been reflected on as-built plans which have been submitted to the approving authority by the Designer prior to the issuance of a Certificate of Compliance.

This means that the Certificate of Compliance will be signed by the Board of Health member after it is signed by the Engineer and the Installer. Please be sure to have the Disposal Works Construction Permit on site.
