

At a regular meeting the Granby Board of Health on October 20, 1975 the Board passed the following regulations:

No subsurface sewage leaching system or septic tank shall be constructed within one hundred feet of any private well, or within one hundred feet of any known source of public surface water supply or tributary thereto. further, no subsurface sewage leaching system or septic tank shall be constructed within one hundred feet in the case of a single or duplex dwelling, or one hundred feet in the case of a commercial building, or of a multiple dwelling, as defined in section one of chapter one hundred and fifty-one B, of the normal spring high water level of any great pond, pond, stream, brook, river, surface or sub-surface drain, swamp, or wetland or of any mean high water for tidal water. This regulation may be waived by the Granby Board of Board for the repair of existing systems.
