September 14, 2021

The regular meeting of the Granby Board of Health was held by conference call/Zoom and opened at 7:00 pm.

Those in attendance were Alan Weiss


1. Board signed the following:
Timesheet for Colleen
Money turnover sheet
Temporary Food Permit for Granby Preservation Society, Craft Fair 10/11/21, with inspection by Lynn.
2. A motion was made, seconded and all were in favor to accept the meeting minutes for August 31, 2021.
3. Sherman & Frydryk submitted a new complete system septic design for a 4-bedroom house at Carver Street lot 8. The review was not completed. The Board did not approve. Another perc and deep hole will have to be done and proposed well clearance demonstrated. Sherman and Frydryk requested more time to resolve issues. They will be scheduled for the next Board meeting.
4. Alan Weiss submitted a new complete system septic design for a 2-bedroom house at Amherst Street lot 2. The review was not completed. The Board did not approve. A second perc at the eastern end of SAS and deep hole will have to be done and the proposed well clearance demonstrated.
5. A complaint regarding water draining onto a neighbor's property from 156 New Ludlow Rd was discussed. Dick will drive by to investigate.
6. The Mass DEP grant for air sensors was discussed. Dick stated he can fill out the form and submit it. Colleen is looking into information about the low-income housing on Amherst Street. The Board will request 6 air sensors for the housing units on Amherst St, The MacDuffie School, The High School, East Meadow School, Town Hall and the asphalt plant on New Ludlow Rd.
7. The Board discussed the October 12 Board meeting. Dick, the Chair will be unavailable so the meeting will be cancelled. Colleen will keep the Board informed if issues arise that would require a Board meeting, otherwise the next meeting after October 12 will be October 26.

8. The Board discussed the mask order. Several complaints have come into the office. Some businesses will not enforce the order. Enforcement would require tickets being issued. Without the state of emergency in effect, the Board does not have the Police as their agents to help with enforcement.
9. The forebays at Dollar General were discussed. The Board has not heard from Dollar General regarding remediation of the forebays despite being sent several letters requesting a schedule of compliance. The Board instructed Colleen to call one more time and if she doesn't hear back a letter should be sent stating that because the storm water system is not functioning like it should the Board will be looking into the process to shut down the parking lot so that no one will be able to use it. If the Board does not hear back, they will start the process of public nuisance procedure. Dick will contact the Town Attorney.
10. The next regular Board of Health meeting will be held on September 28, 2021, 7p.m. via conference call/zoom.
11. The Board adjourned the meeting at 7:45 pm.
