BOARD OF HEALTH MINUTES  
December 6, 2022

The regular meeting of the Granby Board of Health was held by conference call/Zoom and opened at 7:00 pm.

Those present were Dick Bombardier, Lee Lalonde, and Bill Shaheen


Those in attendance were Jeff LeBeau, Jose Alves

1. A motion was made, seconded and Dick and Bill were in favor of accepting the meeting minutes for November 16, 2022. Lee was not in attendance at the time of the vote.
2. The Board voted on and all members approved each of the following items:

  - Money Turnover Sheet
  - Bills payable for Tom Flebotte, animal inspections & mileage
  - Well permit for CT Valley Artesian Well at Morgan Street, lot 3
  - Well permit for Cushing & Sons at East Street, lot 1
  - DSCP for tank replacement at 5 Harris Street, hold until Lee approves
  - Sign-off on well & septic for building dept. for lot 6 Carver Street
  - 2023 permit renewals, food permits subject to Lynn's inspection:

    - Dunkin Donuts, Food Establishment, Retail, Milk & Frozen Dessert
    - Council on Aging, Food Establishment
    - Granby American Legion, Food Establishment

3. The Board members, unanimously received these Title 5 Reports:

4. Jeff Lebeau was present to submit a septic design for a new 3-bedroom complete system, at lot 1, East Street. The review was completed. The Board approved the

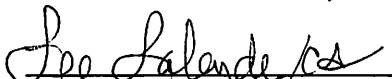
design subject to requiring the connection between tanks to be DEP approved, no need for barrier at wall, additional fill at west end of SAS for reserve, additional deep hole in western area of SAS at installation, fill regulations and trench permit.


5. Jose Alves was present to apply for an Installer's license. After discussion, the Board approved a 2022 Installer's license and a 2023 license once the fee and application are submitted.
6. The Board discussed the request from the Planning Board for review of site plan approval for Kim's Pet Resort at 220 West State Street. The Board instructed the Assistant to send a letter to the Planning Board stating that the Board has no issues with the plan.
7. Dick informed the Board he would be bringing the air sensors to the schools and Chris Martin for installation.
8. The next regular Board of Health meeting will be held on December 20, 2022, 7p.m. via conference call/zoom.
9. The Board adjourned the meeting at 8:20 pm.
