NOTICE OF PLANNING BOARD PUBLIC HEARING  
RELATIVE TO  
ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENTS**

Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 40A, Section 5, the Planning Board of the Town of Granby will hold a public hearing to discuss proposed amendments to the Granby Zoning Bylaw. The hearing will be held as follows:

The subject matter of the proposed Zoning Bylaw amendments are in regard to:

1. Amending Section 1.2 Definitions by adding definition for the following:  
“Renewable or Alternative Energy”
2. Amending Section III - Use Regulations - Subsection 3.0 Schedule of Use Regulations - TABLE 1 SCHEDULE OF USE REGULATIONS by adding a new Bylaw Number 3.063 and Land Use Classification “Accessory uses which are necessary in connection specifically with renewable or alternative energy scientific research, scientific development and related production” – allowed by-right with Site Plan Approval in the Industrial Zoning District 1.
3. Amending Section III - Use Regulations - Subsection 3.0 Schedule of Use Regulations - TABLE 1 SCHEDULE OF USE REGULATIONS by adding a new Bylaw Number 3.097 and Land Use Classification “Research and Development Laboratory specifically for renewable or alternative energy” – allowed by-right with Site Plan Approval in the Industrial Zoning District 1.
4. Amending Section III - Use Regulations - Subsection 3.0 Schedule of Use Regulations - TABLE 1 SCHEDULE OF USE REGULATIONS by adding a new Bylaw Number 3.098 and Land Use Classification “Manufacturing, processing, fabrication, assembly and storage of materials, mechanical products or equipment specifically related to renewable or alternative energy” – allowed by-right with Site Plan Approval in the Industrial Zoning District 1.
