#### **Minutes**

**CALL TO ORDER:** Glen Sexton called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

#### **New Business**

<u>Joint Public Hearing with the Zoning Board of Appeals – William Clark</u> Glen Sexton read the public hearing notice.

Joint Hearing along with Board of Appeals to consider the petition of William Clark seeking a Special Permit under Section 6.2 and Site Plan Approval under Section 6.3 of the Granby Zoning By-Laws, and applicable of Section III-Regulations, 3.7.5 – Accessory Uses, regarding a private garage or stables exceeding Twelve Hundred (1200) feet in area to be located at 198 Batchelor Street, Granby, MA, known as Map 9-B-8.

Jeremy Carrier disclosed Kathleen Bronner is attending per the Rule of Necessity so the ZBA could have enough members to vote.

Mr. Clark reviewed the detailed site plans for a 2,400 square foot barn.

## Questions from the Planning Board/Zoning Board of Appeals

- Lillian Camus noted the dimensions of the proposed barn were handwritten on the site plans A-1 and A-2. Additionally, the scale was rewritten on site plan A-1 from 3/8" = 1'0" to  $\frac{1}{4}$ " = 1'0". Plans A-2 through A-5 show the scale as 3/8" = 1.0". Mrs. Camus requested updated plans showing the dimensions and scale printed so as to avoid any confusion in later years should someone look at the plans.
- Jim Trompke recommend the Board's approval be conditional that before permit is issued, we be supplied with 5 copies plans with the correct scale and dimensions on them.

#### The Zoning Board of Appeals discussed the plans with

Motion made by Jeremy Carrier and seconded by Richard Beaulieu to accept the request for a Special Permit allow to 198 Batchelor Street, Granby Mass with the condition that all six copies of the plans are submitted in full with the proper statements. Motion carried 5 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstained

Motion made by Jim Trompke and seconded by Rob Chauvin to approve the site plans as presented with the condition that a new set of drawings will be submitted showing the correct scale prior to a permit being issued. Motion carried 4 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstained

Glen Sexton signed the Building Permit Application for the Planning Board.
