#### **Voter Registration**

If you are **NOT** registered to vote, the last day to register to vote and change Party enrollment for the State Primary is Saturday August 27th:

<u>In-Person Voter Registration on Saturday, August 27, 2022</u> 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM at the Carnegie Building AKA "Old Public Library" and 1:00 PM - 5:00 PM at the Town Clerk's office at 215 B West State Street.

You may also register anytime during regular office hours in the Town Clerk's office, you can pick up mail in voter registration forms at the Granby Post Office, or the Public Library.

With a valid Massachusetts Drivers' License, or Massachusetts ID you can register on-line at <a href="www.sec.state.ma.us">www.sec.state.ma.us</a> under elections, or on our town website <a href="www.granby-ma.gov">www.granby-ma.gov</a> under the Town Clerk Department.

Mail in forms must be post marked by the August 27th to be eligible to participate in this PRIMARY.

To note: if you did not mail back your 2022 Annual Town Census or voted in the past year you may be listed as an Inactive Voter.

**EARLY VOTING BY MAIL:** Early voting by mail requires no excuse this is "**voting by will**" the last day to file a "Vote By Mail" and an Absentee by Mail application for the Sept. 06, 2022, State Primary is 5 p.m. on Monday, August 29<sup>th</sup>.

If you did not receive an application from the Secretary of the Commonwealth, Elections Division, you may download an application by going on-line to our Town Website under the Town Clerk Department, or at <a href="www.sec.state.ma.us">www.sec.state.ma.us</a>. You may also email the completed application with your signature on it to: <a href="townclerk@granby-ma.gov">townclerk@granby-ma.gov</a> this would be the quickest way for your application to be received.

### **Early Voting In Person**

State Primary, September 6, 2022

**EARLY VOTING IN PERSON** will be held in the *Carnegie Building" AKA "Old Public Library"* located at One Library Lane. You can vote Early In-Person from August 27 & -August 29<sup>th</sup> – September 2<sup>nd</sup>

Carnegie Library Hours for Early Voting Saturday, August 27<sup>th</sup> - 9 a.m. - 1 p.m.

Monday-August 29<sup>th</sup> - Thursday, September 1<sup>st</sup> - 9 a.m. - 3 p.m.

Friday, September 2<sup>nd</sup> - 9am-12 noon

**ABSENTEE VOTING** You must have one of the following reasons to apply for an Absentee Ballot:

- A registered voter who is absent from the voter's city or town during normal polling hours
- A registered voter with a physical disability
- COVID-19 reasons
- Religious belief; OR
- A non-registered voter who is absent from the state; or
- An active member of the armed forces or merchant marines, their spouse or dependent, or
- A person confined in a correctional facility, or a jail, except if by reason of felony conviction

Mail-In Absentee Applications must be received no later than 5 p.m. on Monday, August 29<sup>th</sup> and last day to vote Absentee In-Person in the Town Clerk's office is *Friday*, *September 2<sup>nd</sup>* 9 am- 5 pm
