To one of the constables of the Town of Granby in the County of Hampshire:

Greetings:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and town affairs, to meet at the Granby Junior-Senior High School on East State Street in said Town on Tuesday, the twenty-seventh day of August next, at 7:00 P.M., then and there to act on the following articles, to wit:

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to amend the Bylaws of the Town of Granby Volume I by inserting Chapter XVII Section 8 Public Consumption of Marijuana, or take any other action in regards thereto.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to amend the Bylaws of the Town of Granby Volume I by inserting Chapter XVII Section 9 Ban on Marijuana Establishments, or take any other action in regards thereto.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to amend the Granby Zoning Bylaws by revising SECTION III – USE REGULATIONS Table 1 SCHEDULE OF USE REGULATIONS by inserting a new land Use Classification for retail/commercial cannabis, or take any other action in regard thereto.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to amend the Granby Zoning Bylaws by revising SECTION III – USE REGULATIONS Table 1 SCHEDULE OF USE REGULATIONS by inserting a new land Use Classification for retail/commercial cannabis, or take any other action in regard thereto.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to amend the Granby Zoning Bylaws by revising SECTION V – SPECIAL USE REGULATIONS AND PERFORMANCE STANDARDS by inserting Section 5.12 Cannabis Retail/Growing and Distribution, or take any other action in regard thereto.

- ARTICLE 6.** To see if the Town will vote to amend the Bylaws of the Town of Granby Volume I by rescinding Chapter XVII Section 7 Temporary Marijuana Establishment Moratorium, or take any other action in regards thereto.
- ARTICLE 7.** To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, transfer from the stabilization fund, borrow or bond \$50,000, or a greater or lesser amount, for the purpose of funding an investigation/evaluation of the Forge Pond dam and dike, or take any other action in regard thereto.
- ARTICLE 8.** To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, transfer from the stabilization fund, borrow or bond \$20,000, or a greater or lesser amount, for the purpose of funding a limited site investigation by a licensed site professional as required by MassDEP, or take any other action in regard thereto.


And you are hereby directed to serve this warrant by posting attested copies thereof at five or more public places as of the bylaws before the time of said meeting.
