The polls opened at 7:00 A.M. and closed at 8:00 P.M. There were 566 Democrats, 814 Republicans, and 13 Libertarians that voted in this Presidential Primary. This was a respectable turnout. A total of 1,393 voters came out to support their candidates, this was 27.5% of Granby's voters.

To be eligible to vote in this Presidential Primary you had to be registered by Feb. 24, 2024. At the close of voter registration, the town had 5,044 registered voters, and 373 of those voters were considered "Inactive".

Many of the voters took advantage of voting by mail. The last day to request a mail in ballot for this primary was February 27, 2024.

624 voters voted by mail, and 56 voters took advantage of the "In-Person" Early Voting that was held at the Carnegie Building, AKA" Old Library" from February 24- March 1st.

713 voters voted at the Granby Jr. Sr. High School on Tuesday, March 5th

No provisional ballots were filed.

Record Of The Presidential Primary Held On March 05, 2024, Cont'd

To note: Inactive voters are those individuals who have not answered their annual census or have not voted in past elections or meetings for the last four years. If they remain dormant for four years or two biennial election years, they will be removed from the voting rolls.

Once a voter is removed from the voting rolls, they must re-register to vote. If an individual tries to vote and they are not on the voting rolls they may file a provisional ballot. A provisional ballot will not count unless it is proven that the voter should not have been removed from the voting rolls or should have been registered but somehow was not recorded.

If it is proven that they still should have been on the voting rolls, or they should have been registered then that provisional ballot will be counted.
