Polling Location: Granby Jr. Sr. High School

All Elections are held at the Granby Jr. Sr. High School, in the Gymnasium. Please park in the back and enter through the Gymnasium doors. Checking in for elections goes by your Precinct number.

## Early Voting By Mail:

If you did not file with the Town Clerk, the "Vote-By-Mail" application that the Secretary's Office from the Commonwealth mailed out back in January, and you wish to file for an application to get a "Vote-By-Mail" ballot for the Annual Town Election, the application MUST be received in the Town Clerks office by 5 p.m. on Monday, May 13th.

You may email the completed "Vote-By-Mail" application with your signature on it to townclerk@granby-ma.gov this would be the quickest way for your application to be received, or you can drop it in the Election Drop Box outside my office at 215 B West State St, or process it through the USPS.

After May 13th you will only be able to vote at the polls on Monday, May 20th

Polling hours 12noon-7 p.m. or if you qualify you may file for an Absentee Ballot in the Town Clerk's office, last day to file is Friday, May 17, 2024, at 5 p.m.

## **Absentee Voting In-Person**

Who qualifies for an Absentee Ballot? A registered voter who will be unable to vote at the polls on Election Day due to absence from the town during polling hours, disability, or religious beliefs may file for an Absentee Ballot.

Do you know what precinct you are? Not sure call the town clerk's office or look on the web site www.granby-ma.gov under department of town clerk.

If you did not answer your 2024 town census, or confirmation mailing you may be listed as an Inactive Voter. To avoid any problems at the Town Meeting or at the Election please call the town clerk's office to verify your voting status.
