CHECK YOUR PAINT CONTAINER

CONDITION:	WHAT TO DO:
LATEX PAINT	→ If liquid, dry out by mixing with kitty litter until it is the consistency of oatmeal, or air dry and then place in trash
OIL BASED PAINT AND PAINT PRODUCTS	→ Save for Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Day
Not in original container, probably oil paint or thinner	→ Save for Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Day
Paint has been frozen or is dried out. (Frozen paint has separated lines/cracks, looks like cottage cheese, and may smell bad.)	→ If latex has dried out completely, may be placed in trash → If oil-based, save for HHW day
Aerosol paint or paint product?	→ Save for HHW day
Read the label-does it contain any of the following: Lead, mercury, chromium Pentachlorophenol Creosote Pesticide/fungicide Wood bleach Methyl ethyl ketone Toluene Xylene	→ Save for HHW day
Is it one of the following: Epoxy Two-part paint Pool paint Fire retardant Rubber based	→ Save for HHW day
