

**COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS
TOWN OF GRANBY
SPECIAL TOWN MEETING**

Hampshire, ss:

To one of the constables of the Town of Granby in the County of Hampshire:

Greetings:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and town affairs, to meet at the Granby Junior-Senior High School on East State Street in said Town on Monday, the eighteenth day of June next, at 7:15 P.M., then and there to act on the following articles, to wit:

- ARTICLE 1.** To see if the Town will vote to transfer from account number 01-135-5112-000 to account number 01-135-5301-000 the sum of \$17,276, or take any other action in regards thereto.
- ARTICLE 2.** To see if the Town will vote to increase the asset (whole estate) limit to \$39,000 for single persons and \$42,000 for married couples as allowed under Massachusetts General Law, Chapter 59 Section 5 Clause 41C relating to the exemption of real estate taxes on property of elderly persons to be effective for exemptions granted for any fiscal year beginning on or after July 1, 2003, or take any other action in regards thereto.
- ARTICLE 3.** To see if the Town will vote to accept Massachusetts General Law, Chapter 59 Section 5 Clause 17E, which authorizes an annual increase in the asset (whole estate) limit for exemptions granted to senior citizens, surviving spouses and surviving minors under Massachusetts General Law, Chapter 59 Section 5 Clause 17D by up to 100% of the percentage increase in the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, Consumer Price Index for the previous year as determined by the Commissioner of Revenue and to fix that annual increase at 2.5% or 100% of the Consumer Price Index, whichever is less, to be effective for exemptions granted for any fiscal year beginning on or after July 1, 2012, or take any other action in regards thereto.

And you are hereby directed to serve this warrant by posting attested copies thereof at five or more public places as of the bylaws before the time of said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make due return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk at the time and place of meeting aforesaid.
