**Greetings:**

**In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and town affairs, to meet at the Granby Junior-Senior High School on East State Street in said Town on Monday, the thirteenth day of June next, at 7:10 P.M., then and there to act on the following articles, to wit:**

- ARTICLE 1.** To see if the Town will vote to authorize and appropriate, borrow or transfer from available funds the sum of \$22,885, or a greater or lesser amount, for the purpose of funding the Public Buildings Personal Services budget for FY2016, or take any other action in regards thereto.
- ARTICLE 2.** To see if the Town will vote to authorize and appropriate, borrow or transfer from available funds the sum of \$33,000, or a greater or lesser amount, for the purpose of funding the Ambulance Department Personal Services budget for FY2016, or take any other action in regard thereto.
- ARTICLE 3.** To see if the Town will vote to transfer the remaining balance in the Cable receipts Reserved For Appropriation account as of June 30, 2016 to the PEG Access and Cable Related Fund, or take any other action in regard thereto.

**And you are hereby directed to serve this warrant by posting attested copies thereof at five or more public places as of the bylaws before the time of said meeting.**

**Hereof fail not and make due return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk at the time and place of meeting aforesaid.**
